1) The success grade in a course is determined by evaluating the student's activities and exams together during the year.

(2) If no activity has been done in a lesson, for the student to be considered successful in a lesson; The sum of 40% of the midterm exam average and 60% of the final exam or make-up exam results is graded as letter grade and coefficient according to the table below, provided that a minimum score of 50 points is obtained in the final or make-up exams.

(3) All activities such as homework, projects, etc., which are not included in the midterm exam during the year, are called "Others" and the result of the evaluation is entered as a separate grade in the automation system. The contribution rate of these activities to the success grade is determined by the relevant instructor. The contribution of the activities to be carried out from any course to the success grade is reported to the unit student affairs department by taking the decision of the relevant administrative board.

(4) In order for a course to be considered successful, the final or make-up exam grade must not be less than 50% of the full grade, and the course success grade must not be less than 50% of the full grade.

F1 grade: It is given to students who are absent, general and who do not have the right to take make-up exams if it is decided to be held. Students who are absent even though they do not have a passing grade on their own are given an F1 grade as a midterm exam grade.

F2 grade: It is given to students who continue but do not take the general or make-up exam if it is decided to be held. Students who do not take the midterm exam, although they do not have a passing grade on their own, are given an F2 grade as a midterm grade.

G grade: Given to students who are successful in non-credit courses.

K grade: It is given to students who fail non-credit courses.

M grade: It is given for the courses that the student is exempted from.

The student must have passed all the courses required to graduate from a program and must have a general academic achievement grade point average of at least 2.00. Students whose average is below 2.00 must take courses again from courses with a CD grade or less in order to raise their average to 2.00.
